After reconsideration, the decision at trial was affirmed disallowing payment to the lien claimant, Orthopedic Care Center of Los Angeles Medical Group, through its physician Dr. Kyle Landauer, for medical services and medication provided from 6/23/2003 – 1/3/2007 for lack of a Fictitious Name Permit as discussed in *Stokes v Patton State Hospital/Dept. of Mental Health/State of California (2007)72 Cal.Comp.Cases 996* (Significant Panel Decision). The burden of proof is on the lien claimant to establish proper licensure and, if services were provided under a fictitious business name, that the claimant filed a fictitious business name with the county clerk and that a fictitious name permit was issued by the Medical Board. The lien claimant's Writ of Review was denied.
